## NOTICE OF COMPLETION: CATARAQUI BAY WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE SCHEDULE "C" CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT UTILITIES KINGSTON

Utilities Kingston has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the Cataraqui Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade. The Environmental Assessment was initiated to assess the plant's existing conditions, address the more stringent effluent quality, accommodate for urban population growth, recommend preferred treatment technologies, and develop preliminary site layouts and Opinion of Probable Cost. The plant treatment capacity will increase from the current 38 800 m³/d to 68 000 m³/d, which allows for the flow contribution from Portsmouth sewershed. The recommended undertaking is to expand the plant with the Biological Aerated Filters (BAF) as the liquid train process, and with Anaerobic Digestion and an Enclosed Biosolids Cake Storage Facility as solids train process. The digester gas produced will be utilized by boilers for heating when required, or wasted by flare.

The project is being planned under the Schedule C of the Municipal Class EA. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of necessary approvals, Utilities Kingston intends to proceed with the design and construction of this project. A copy of the request must also be sent to Utilities Kingston. If no request is received within 30 calendar days of this Notice, Utilities Kingston will be permitted to proceed to design and construction as outlined in the Environmental Study Report.
