

7.0 PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

A number of notifications, permits and approvals may be required for this undertaking, as illustrated in Table 7.1. An appropriate amount of time should be scheduled to obtain all necessary permits and approvals prior to construction.

Notifications, Permits and Approvals

Agency	Notification/Permit/Approval
Cataraqui Region Conservation Authority	Fill, Construction and Alteration to Waterways permit detailing site plan, schedule of works, methods to be used, erosion control measures and revegetation plan. Permit to cross lands through easement.
Ministry of Environment	Approval for disposal of contaminated soils (if identified during excavation activities). Permit to take and discharge water for hydrostatic testing.
Ministry of Culture	Stage II Assessment Clearance Letter. Permit to excavate or alter archaeological and historical sites (if heritage resources are encountered).
Ministry of Transportation	Crossing Permit for construction affecting Highway 401.
Utilities	Agreement on construction procedures to undercross their facilities.
Canadian National Railway	Permits to cross their facilities.
City of Kingston	Approval of construction plans for road crossings and a traffic management plan.
Trans-Northern Pipelines	Permit to cross petroleum products pipeline.
Trans-Canada Pipelines	Permit to cross petroleum products pipeline.
Enbridge Pipelines	Permit to cross petroleum products pipeline.
Union Gas	Permit to cross petroleum products pipeline (if required).
Ministry of Culture	Clearance Certificate (given after Stage II Archaeological Assessment)
