

PUBLIC LIAISON COMMITTEE (PLC) MEMBERS WANTED

Environmental Assessment (EA) for Upgrades to the Cana Wastewater Treatment Plant

A Public Liaison Committee (PLC) is being established for this study to:

- Provide input on consultation activities to ensure that community information needs are met;
- Provide input on information to be presented at each open house and other consultation activities and review the consultation reports completed after each PLC and open house; and,
- Attend public open houses to provide a strong link between the project team and the residents of the City of Kingston.

Utilities Kingston is seeking two to four members to sit on the PLC. Members of the Public Liaison Committee will be expected to attend the public open houses. PLC members are also expected to attend approximately three PLC meetings during the EA, scheduled to be completed over the next year.
