**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING  
UTILITIES KINGSTON**

**LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT THE UTILITIES KINGSTON (HIGH  
PRESSURE NATURAL GAS PIPELINE IN THE CITY OF KINGSTON)  
CONSISTING OF A 13.4 KILOMETER NPS 8 AND NPS 12 INCH  
PIPELINE**

Utilities Kingston has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the Board) dated March 4, 2005, under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). Utilities Kingston has applied for an Order of the Board for leave to construct 13.4 km of pipeline between the Glenburnie Gate Station and the Central Heating Plant at Queen's University in the City of Kingston.

The proposed pipeline is located entirely within the boundaries of the City of Kingston. It will originate at the existing Glenburnie Gate Station, proceed south on Perth Road, west on Bur Brook Road, south on Sunnyside Road, overland to Binnington Court and south along a City of Kingston easement, east along Dalton Road, south on Sir John A. MacDonald Boulevard, east on Johnson Street, south on Albert Street, east on Union Street, south on University Avenue, east on Stuart Street and then south on Lower University Avenue to the south side of King Street at the Central Heating Plant at Queen's University, where the pipeline terminates.

A map showing the location of the proposed pipeline is included in this notice. The Board has assigned the application File No. EB-2005-0247.

The proposed pipeline will be constructed, owned and operated by Utilities Kingston. Construction of the pipeline will allow Utilities Kingston to improve overall system reliability to meet the increasing gas requirements for current and future customers, to reinforce the existing pipeline and to supply the proposed co-generation facility at the

Queen's University Central Heating Plant.

Utilities Kingston plans to start construction in summer 2005 and bring the pipeline into service in November 2005.

The Board intends to proceed with the application by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is appropriate. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board within 10 calendar days of the delivery or publication date of this Notice.
