If one or more do not accept, those with the next best scores will be invited to participate, until all positions are filled.

4. A signed original of the application form is on file with Utilities Kingston (Assign 1 point if yes).		
5. The application met the deadline of 4:00 p.m., February 1, 2008 (Assign 1 point if yes).		
6. The applicant has potentially significant time constraints (Subtract points).
